

AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES HELD IN THE SESSION 2018-19

The first important activity of the school of the session 2018-19 was on 21st April 18 called as Investiture Ceremony. The deputy commandant of 21 Battalion SSB Bagaha 2 was the Chief Guest of the day. The Chief Guest appreciated so much the solemnity of the Programme. Then within a few days of gap Montfort Feast was celebrated on 28th April 18. A small cultural program and a solemn Eucharistic celebration were held in the community hall with all the Christian students and the teachers which were followed by a festive lunch. In the month of November inter house and inter class tournaments for football cricket and Khokho were organized. It almost took two weeks to finish the tournaments.

2nd December 2018 was the great day for the school. The annual day of the school was celebrated with great pomp and extravaganza which attracted almost 2500 to 3000 audiences. Principal of Christ Raja School Bettiah was the Chief Guest, who gave away the prizes and medals to the winners of some 65 items of seniors, juniors and sub juniors categories.

The school also celebrated 26th January 2019 with much interest and preparation in order to keep up and generate love and patriotism in the children. During this session (2019-20) the investiture ceremony was organized with much pomp and elegance. For the first time the School- Band was created comprising of 33 members in the band.
